The United States consist of 50 states:


- **48** of them

New York


- the **biggest city** of the U.S.A.

- the assassination of President Kennedy
in 1963 took place here



Political System

- the U.S. are a **federal constitutional republic**
→ power is divided between the **Federal Government** and the **state governments**
- based on the **Constitution of 1789**
- **the Federal Government** consists of three departments:
 - 1) the Executive Department (the President)
 - 2) the Congress
 - 3) the Supreme Court

The President of the U.S.A.

- nowadays **Barrack Obama** (44th American President)
- elected every **4 years**
- his official residence is the **White House**
in Washington D.C.



The Congress

- has 2 houses – the **Senate** and
the **House of Representatives**
- its seat is in the **Capitol** in Washington D.C.

Outstanding Personalities:

- in literature: Nobel Prize winners Ernest **Hemingway** and John **Steinbeck**
- in science: Thomas Alva **Edison** - invented the electric bulb, Albert **Einstein** - a famous physicist born in Germany, later lived in the U.S., formulated the theory of relativity
- in music: Ella **Fitzgerald** - a jazz singer, George **Gershwin** - a composer, Elvis **Presley** - a rock-and-roll singer
